
APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

WHAT CLUBS SHOULD EXPECT FROM APPLICANTS

FROM 1 JULY, 2017 ALL APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP (OR RENEWAL) MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE

It is a condition of joining any Club that an applicant has

- *completed a course of instruction in the sport of Archery with the Club or another Archery Australia Club **OR***
- *is transferring from an existing Archery Club **OR***
- *is a renewing (or previous) Club Member.*

The online process requires the following details:

- Surname
- Given Name
- Gender
- Date of Birth
- Residential Address
- Contact Telephone Number
- Email address
- Current/Intended Bow Type: Recurve / Compound / Longbow / Crossbow
- Style: Freestyle / Barebow / Archer with a Disability: (Standing / Wheelchair)
- Details of any medical, physical or intellectual condition/injury that may either be aggravated or that may impair the applicant's ability to participate in archery?
- Membership Type Applied for: Shooting Member / Non-Shooting Member / Associate / Social
- Membership Category Applied for: Adult / Minor / Family (number of adults & number of minor)

Applicants must visit the online membership portal to make application to join the Club or to renew an annual membership

Cash, Cheque or EFT payments are not acceptable

A series of declarations are required to be acknowledged by each applicant. These need to be acknowledged each year, as they can change from one year to the next. They can include statements such as the following example:

I declare:

- That I am not aware of any health issues or disabilities which would endanger the safety of myself or others or, if I do have such issues, I will notify the Club Secretary in writing before engaging in archery-related activity.

I hereby consent to:

- The collection and use my personal images, results, awards and prizes received. I acknowledge these may be used by the Club, Recognised Governing Bodies (RGBs) and Archery Australia for websites, newsletters and publications for the promotion of the sport.

I further acknowledge that:

- My images, results, awards and prizes received may be used by the Club and Media to promote the Club. I understand that some personal information such as scores and achievements can be viewed by anyone who accesses Club, RGBs and Archery Australia websites or publications or general media and that my consent can be withdrawn at any time, upon written notice to the Club Secretary.

Your privacy is our priority. All personal information you have provided will help us process your application to become a member. The Club, ARCHERY South Australia and Archery Australia may use your information to communicate with you and inform you of activities and events. I agree to abide by:

- The Essence of Australian Sport Code of Conduct (available at <http://www.ausport.gov.au/supporting/clubs>), the General Provisions of the Code of Behaviour being (and intended to be the minimum standard for anyone involved in the sport of archery):
- Operate within the rules and spirit of the sport, promoting fair play over winning at any cost
 - Encourage and support opportunities for people to learn appropriate behaviours and skills
 - Support opportunities for participation in all aspects of the sport
 - Treat each person as an individual
 - Display control and courtesy to all involved with the sport
 - Respect the rights and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
 - Respect the decisions of officials, coaches and administrators in the conduct of the sport
 - Wherever practical, avoid unaccompanied and unobserved one-on-one activity (when in a supervisory capacity or where a power imbalance will exist) with people under the age of 18 years
 - Adopt appropriate and responsible behaviour in all interactions
 - Adopt responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs
 - Act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions
 - Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment
 - Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a harassment free environment
 - Do not tolerate harmful or abusive behaviours.

ADDITIONAL (FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP ONLY):

- I understand and acknowledge that:
- A Club Associate is a person who is already registered with Archery Australia and ARCHERY South Australia through one Club, but is also seeking Associate Membership with this Club
 - I am required to pay the Club Associate fee charged by this Club, but I am not required to pay the Archery Australia or ARCHERY South Australia components of the fees (as these have been paid to my principal Club) (My full membership with the principal Club is due to expire on / /)
 - In tournaments, I will represent the Club through which I am registered (affiliated) with Archery Australia and ARCHERY South Australia
